




Centre's Annual Report on ENTREPRENEURIAL INITIATIVES, ACTIVITIES & ACHIEVEMENTS

(Overview) June 2020- May 2021

Established in 2009, the Centre for Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development (CIED), aims to prepare men and women to lead, innovate, and think entrepreneurially in business, public and social service, to be job creators and role models. For the past 13 years, we have inspired, educated, and empowered potential entrepreneurs as they innovate and create business ventures. Our mission is to support and mentor the entrepreneurial ambitions of BIMTECH students, alumni, faculty and the community at large and turn BIMTECH into a crucible for entrepreneurship initiatives. We do this by providing inspiration, driving team formation, and facilitating venture development. These days, great business ideas can come from anywhere. To encourage them, we need to increase the breadth and depth of the entrepreneurial ecosystem by multiplying connections among entrepreneurs and mentors, improving access to entrepreneurial education, creating events and activities that activate all the participants in the start-up community, and much more.

In congruence with this core idea, in the last academic year of June 2020 to May 2021, the Centre carried out various activities. They are collated under 7 heads, viz.





1. Advisory Board of the Centre

For the academic year 2020-21, CIED had 13 Advisory Board members.

2. Members of the Expert Panel of Mentors

The Centre has created an expert Panel of Mentors to support the budding entrepreneurs. The Centre is utilizing the services of eleven mentors for this initiative.

3. Atal Incubation Centre-BIMTECH

The institute was one of the first ten selections out of the 3658 first-round applicants for Atal Incubation Centres by the Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) in 2016-17. AIC-BIMTECH is one of a kind academia-industry- government partnership, driven by AIM, to create high-class incubation facilities with suitable infrastructure in terms of capital equipment and operating facilities. AIC-BIMTECH is working on a three-stage incubation process for the incubatees, viz. Khoj, Gurukul, and Udaan. Since its inception on 20th January 2018, it has hosted 113 incubatees.

4. Our Covid Warriors

Last year we showcased the work being done by four AIC-BIMTECH startups Probano, Uneako Green, Ypanx Technologies, and Concis. This year we bring to you the details of three more startups from our incubator, who are contributing their efforts to the fight against COVID.

These are:

a) Sarvodaya Infotech Pvt Ltd

Sarvodaya Infotech launched Aarogya Path, an online portal that connects healthcare consumers with service providers such as hospitals, pathology labs, research institutes, and medical supply stores. It will help to alleviate supply chain bottlenecks created by the Covid-19 pandemic. The platform will fill a critical gap in the last-mile delivery of medical care by increasing the availability and affordability of healthcare supplies. It helps in the prevention of opportunistic pricing and medical equipment hoarding.

b) Anima Drive

Ashoka Innovators For The Public recognized the COVID-19 relief efforts of an AIC-BIMTECH startup founder, Rishabh Pratap Singh. At the height of the pandemic, Rishabh noticed that positive cases were increasing rapidly in his village. So, he and his Village Mitra team gathered some funds and increased the number of water hand pumps to reduce crowding near water supply points.

c) Sarna Educational and Cultural Services LLP

The COVID-19 pandemic and the accompanying lockdown measures have significantly impacted indigenous communities in Odisha. Sarna, an AIC-BIMTECH startup, came up with a novel approach to assisting these communities. The team's goal was to help indigenous groups in developing self-sufficiency through livelihood generation. This one-of-a-kind strategy included a community-engaged model that also catered to their immersive travel experience business.

5. Special Initiatives & Activities

We never miss out on opportunities that tend to evoke innovations and can strengthen the Entrepreneurial Culture. This year's special initiatives included:

a) Prarambh Program with Startup Odisha

AIC-BIMTECH partnered with Startup Odisha to launch Prarambh, an eight-week long, zero-fee, and virtual program meant to empower Odishabased startups. Fourteen startups selected for the program are working with Startup Odisha and AIC-BITMECH. They will get access to counseling and intensive mentoring. The performance and progress of their ventures will be closely monitored and tracked by Atal Incubation Centre-BIMTECH.

b) Saturday Roundtable on Entrepre-neurship with Chevening Alumni India

The Atal Incubation Centre - BIMTECH and the Chevening Alumni India are teaming up for a series of virtual roundtable discussions on entrepreneurship. This Saturday Roundtable Discussion on Entrepreneurship series brings distinguished guests from academic institutions, industry figures, innovators, entrepreneurs, investors, and policymakers. During each one-hour event, which is being held online on Airmeet, our esteemed panelists engage in a robust discussion and exploration of a spectrum of topics related to entrepreneurship.

c) AIC-BIMTECH selected as an implementing partner of the Young SDG Innovators Programme

UN Global Compact Network India has selected AIC-BIMTECH as an implementing partner of the Young SDG Innovators Programme.

The program's goal is to encourage SDG

- innovation through bottom-up approaches to develop breakthrough solutions with social and market value. It aims to create a new generation of sustainable business leaders.
- d) Atal Incubation Centre BIMTECH selected as the New Delhi Accelerator for K-Startup Center (KSC) 2021 Program

KISED has launched the K-Startup Center Program to assist South Korean growth-stage startups in entering overseas markets. Atal Incubation Centre - BIMTECH has been selected as the New Delhi accelerator. The program will help promote foreign investments in India and strengthen economic ties between India and South Korea.

e) Relaunch of the Newsletter

AIC-BIMTECH relaunched its quarterly newsletter, "The Entrepreneurial Pulse" The quarterly newsletter curates the best content from India's startup ecosystem and other updates from AIC. The relaunch issue included our Incubator Locator Tool, an online tool in which we mapped India's incubator ecosystem. This issue also had a quick roundup of news from Startup Landscape, forthcoming industry events, and forthcoming industry announcements.







6. Academic Activities

Foundation Day Address on Innovation and Atma Nirbhar Bharat

2nd October is celebrated to honour the birth anniversary of the father of the nation, Mahatma Gandhi. The same day also marks a year's addition to BIMTECH's glorious journey. This year for the 33rd Foundation Day Celebration, we had an acclaimed academic leader, Dr. Rishikesha T Krishnan, Director, IIM Bengaluru was our Chief Guest. He addressed on an important topic, "Innovation and Atma Nirbhar Bharat."

b) Basant Kumar Birla Distinguished Research Scholar Awards

BIMTECH has announced the prestigious Basant Kumar Birla Distinguished Research Scholar Awards, which recognize senior research scholars in India in the fields of Industry 4.0, Sustainability, Corporate Social Responsibility, Ethical Practices, Entrepreneurship, and Family Business.

c) Business Literature Festival 2021

BIMTECH organized a one of its kind virtual Business Literature Festival 2021. The event was graced by the best in the business world along with the literature that they have come up with. To encourage budding entrepreneurs and give them interesting insights into successful entrepreneurship, we organized a Panel Talk on "Creating Unicorns." The panel included Mr. Abhijit Bhaduri, Mr. Hari T.N, and Mr. Sanjeev Agarwal. The session was moderated by Dr. Abha Rishi, CEO, AIC-BIMTECH.

d) Mr. Sunil Cheruvilly, Manager of the CIED, was bid farewell by BIMTECH

BIMTECH bid farewell to Mr. Sunil Cheruvilly, Manager, Centre for Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development (CIED). During his tenure, BIMTECH was selected by the Atal Innovation Mission, NITI Aayog, as Atal Incubation Centre-BIMTECH. He efficiently coordinated all the activities, including entrepreneurial lecture series both online and offline.

e) E-CELL Programs

• Q-thinker

Q-thinker was an event in which participants were challenged to think of a product/service that is not seamless and has issues according to them. They had to come up with novel solutions to the problems. BIMTECH's E-CELL organized this event

to provide a platform for upcoming managers to showcase their innovative ideas that they conceived during the new normal

Corporate Roadies

Corporate Roadies was organized by BIMTECH's E-CELL. The event was a collection of activities to test a person's business insight, abilities, and information. The activities were designed to throw the worst at students, to bring out the best in them.

Invento



About Atal Incubation Centre - BIMTECH

Atal Innovation Mission (AIM): It is a Government of India endeavor to promote the culture of innovation and entrepreneurship, driven by Niti Aayog. AIM supports the establishment of new incubation centres called Atal Incubation Centres. In January 2018, AIM selected the Birla Institute of Management Technology (BIMTECH) to set up Atal Incubation Centre - BIMTECH (AIC-BIMTECH) for turning the vision of Atal Innovation Mission into reality. The Institute was one of the first ten selections out of the 3658 firstround applicants.

AIC-BIMTECH is a sector agnostic business incubator driven by Atal Innovation Mission to create high-class incubation facilities with suitable infrastructure in terms of capital equipment and operating facilities. Built over a total area of 16,500 sqft, it also offers a facility of co-working and co-living space to its incubatees. It is coupled with the availability of sector-wise experts for mentoring the startups to become successful entrepreneurs and enterprises.

Atal Incubation Centre - BIMTECH has incubated more than 113 startups since its inception that have raised over 10.13 cr in funding to date. AIC-BIMTECH has created 376 jobs via the incubated startups supported to date. It has 82 Corporate and Academic partnerships and over 42 international and local mentors. The innovation here lies in focusing on creating sustainable businesses through various public and private partnerships by providing market access and capital.







AIC-BIMTECH Startup Launched Platform To Address Healthcare Supply Chain Issues

The public health emergency caused by the COVID-19 pandemic has wreaked havoc on the medical supply chain. Every step of the manufacturing process for critical medical supplies has been disrupted, hindering the ability to manufacture and distribute critical medical supplies. As a result, the country's healthcare system faces significant challenges in maintaining or expanding the capacity of its facilities to treat patients. Sarvodaya Infotech Pvt. Ltd. (Truck Suvidha) joined forces with the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) to launch a National Healthcare Supply Chain Portal to tackle these logistics challenges. It inspired the development of Aarogya Path, a web-based healthcare supply chain solution that will assist in tracking the real-time availability of essential medical supplies and will help to alleviate supply chain bottlenecks created by the Covid-19 pandemic. Aarogya Path is an online portal that connects healthcare consumers with service providers such as hospitals, pathology labs, research institutes, and medical supply stores. Its holistic and comprehensive way of capturing data serves to prevent overproduction and aids in anticipating shortages of critical medical supplies. During the second wave of the pandemic, Aarogya Path played an essential role in providing patients with the best lead on emergency medical help. It aided individuals and doctors in locating plasma donors for patients in need and helped arrange and transport COVID-related supplies such as oxygen cylinders, oxygen concentrators, and medicines.

Ashoka Innovators For The Public recognizes the COVID-19 relief efforts of an AIC-BIMTECH startup founder, Rishabh Pratap Singh

All it takes is one person to make a difference. Rishabh Pratap Singh, the founder of the Anima Drive, realized that he could be the catalyst for a movement that would help his village's residents who have been affected by the pandemic. During the peak of the pandemic, Rishabh noticed that covid positive cases were rapidly increasing in his village. When he looked into what was causing the massive increase in infection, he discovered that the real cause was large groups gathering without maintaining social distance near the village's only water supply point, a hand pump. Rishabh realized that the solution was to increase the number of water supply points in the village. So, he and his Village Mitra team gathered and raised some funds and increased the number of water hand pumps, which reduced the crowding near water supply points and dramatically slowed the spread of the virus. This pandemic relief initiative by Rishabh and his team, which directly impacted 1250 people in his village, was highlighted by Ashoka Innovators For The Public on the social media platforms.



Sarna, an AIC-BIMTECH Startup, Is Assisting Odisha's Tribal Groups and Weaver Community During the COVID-19 Pandemic

While the entire world is dealing with the COVID-19 pandemic, Indigenous communities are particularly vulnerable due to the inequalities they face. Both the pandemic and the accompanying lockdown measures have significantly impacted indigenous peoples' traditional livelihoods. Sarna Educational And Cultural Services LLP (Sarna) observed the differentiated impact that COVID-19 was having on indigenous peoples. Sarna wanted to directly impact the lives of indigenous communities of Odisha. The team came up with a strategy to help the indigenous groups by developing self-sustainability through livelihood generation.



This unique strategy encompassed a community-engaged model that would also cater to their immersive travel experience business. As part of their immersive travel product, Sarna hired tribal people for housekeeping, tribal folklore storytelling, food preparation, as tour guides, and as hosts for travelers. Sarna's activities have significantly aided the livelihoods of Odisha's indigenous communities. In addition to this, Sarna organized a live event in association with CANSA, Canada, to help connect Odisha's weaver community with international buyers. This one-of-a-kind event got overwhelming responses. This exposure to international buyers greatly aided Odisha's weaver community in selling their goods, which had seen a significant drop in demand due to pandemic-related lockdown measures

Institute's Response Against COVID-19 Pandemic

The outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic continues to inflict enormous damage to communities and economies across the globe. The lockdown of cities and entire nations has been the most common strategy adopted by governments worldwide to prevent the spread of the virus. These daily wagers have greatly suffered due to sudden enforcement of the lockdown that derailed the entire transport system and left them stranded in the middle of nowhere, with no one to ensure their well-being, and their very survival was at stake. In response to the COVID-19 pandemic's devastation, many industrialists, corporate bodies, non-governmental organizations, civil society members, and academic institutions stepped forward to mitigate the pandemic's impact on the poor and society at large. Birla Institute of Management Technology (BIMTECH), imbued with the Birla family's philanthropic legacy, is committed to nurturing responsible business leaders and building resilient and inclusive communities. BIMTECH Bid Farewell to Mr. Sunil Cheruvilly, the Manager of the Centre for Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development






